UTAH LAW* REQUIRES THAT LABORATORIES SUBMIT CLINICAL MATERIAL FROM ALL CASES IDENTIFIED WITH ORGANISMS LISTED BELOW TO THE UTAH PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY (UPHL) WITHIN 3 WORKING DAYS OF IDENTIFICATION

Clinical material is defined as:

- A clinical isolate containing the organism, or
- If an isolate is not available, material containing the organism, in the following order of preference:
 - A patient specimen,
 - o Nucleic acid, or
 - o Other laboratory material.
