Picking Safer Injection Sites:

Green Areas

Are generally the safest.
Inject into the vein toward
the heart.

Yellow Areas:

Hands-Veins are smaller.
Remove rings, avoid
palms and wrists.
Legs-Can lead to
abscesses, swelling, and
the risk of infection and
clots are high.

Red Areas

Neck and groin areas are dangerous. Hitting an artery can cause severe bleeding. Clotting is risk. Can also cause nerve damage.
